Such words splitting takes place only if the original word is not found in the dictionary. For example, “<i>dumptruckdriver</i>” was not found in the dictionary, the engine makes an attempt to locate its valid sub-words (“<i>dump</i>”, “<i>truck</i>”, and “<i>driver</i>”). If all its sub-words are correctly spelled, then the word “<i>dumptruckdriver</i>” will be considered as a correct one. |
