

# What symbols are allowed for Dictionaries API?

On the WebSpellChecker version 5.28.4.0+ for both User and Custom Dictionaries APIs the following symbols are allowed:

- Apostrophe (0x0027), fullwidth apostrophe (0xFF07), full stop (0x002E);
- ANY letter or digit, except
  - modifier letter: <https://www.compart.com/en/unicode/category/Lm>,
  - letter number: <https://www.compart.com/en/unicode/category/Nl>,
  - other number: <https://www.compart.com/en/unicode/category/No>;
- ANY dash (hyphen): <https://www.compart.com/en/unicode/category/Pd>.

A word for the dictionaries is considered valid if it contains at least one letter. Words that consist solely of numbers, apostrophes, or any other non-letter characters are not considered valid.
